GREEN, WALKABLE & CONNECTED



Alexandria is served by two train stations: Green Square and Redfern. Both stations are on the T4 Eastern Suburbs and Illawarra line and are only a few minutes away from Alexandria by train.



Alexandria is serviced by several bus routes, including the 308, 309, 310, 355, and 370 buses. These buses connect Alexandria to other nearby suburbs and the city centre.



Alexandria is located near several major roads, including the Eastern Distributor, Southern Cross Drive, and the M5 Motorway. There is also plenty of street parking and parking garages available in the area.



Alexandria is a bike-friendly suburb, with several dedicated bike lanes and bike rental options available. The suburb is also connected to the city centre via the Bourke Street Cycleway.



Alexandria is a relatively compact suburb and is easily walkable. It is also connected to nearby suburbs, such as Newtown and Erskineville, via several pedestrian-friendly paths and walkways.

1 ALEXANDRIA PARK

This large public park features sports fields, a playground, a skate park, basketball court, and a fitness station. It's a great place for families, dog walkers, and sports enthusiasts.

2 THE ROCK CLIMBING GYM

Located on Bowden Street, this indoor climbing gym offers a range of climbing experiences for all levels of climbers, as well as fitness classes and yoga.

3 THE ALEXANDRIA TRAIL

This scenic walking and cycling path runs through Alexandria and connects to the wider network of trails along Sydney's waterways. It's a great way to explore the area and enjoy the outdoors.

4 GUNYAMA PARK AQUATIC CENTRE

Home to four pools. Indoors, there's a 25m heated program pool, leisure pool and hydrotherapy pool. Head outside to the 50m heated outdoor pool set within a larger, irregular shaped 'beach pool'.


5 ALEXANDRIA TENNIS COURTS

The Alexandria outpost for Tuga Pastries, a tiny Clovelly bakery famed for some of Sydney's best pasteis de nata (Portuguese tarts).



This award-winning distillery offers guided tours, tastings, and masterclasses. It's a great place to learn about the art of distilling and enjoy some unique Australian spirits.


6 REDFERN SURF CLUB



COMING SOON TO ALEXANDRIA

1 ALEXANDRIA PARK COMMUNITY CENTRE

The City of Sydney is currently constructing a new community centre in Alexandria Park, which will include a range of facilities, such as meeting rooms, a performance space, and a kitchen.

2 ALEXANDRIA CANAL PEDESTRIAN & CYCLIST BRIDGE

The City of Sydney is also building a new pedestrian and cyclist bridge over the Alexandria Canal, which will improve connectivity between Alexandria and nearby suburbs.

3 24-HOUR CULTURAL PRECINCT

A new 24-hour trading area with an arts, cultural and entertainment focus would be encouraged in a heritage warehouse precinct in north Alexandria, between McEvoy Street to the north and Alexandra Canal to the south.


4 SYDNEY PARK CYCLING CENTRE
